

## Sociology 4111 (Uggen) midterm grades

As the distribution below makes clear, many of you did *really* well on the first midterm exam. In fact, you did better on this exam than any other class that I've had. The letter grades are only approximations, but I know that you'll want to see how your score stacks up against those of others in the class.

The table shows the curve (e.g., about 40% got A or A-, about 75% got a grade of B or higher). I graphed this curve against a straight curve (90=A; 80=B; 70=C; 60=D; <60=F), so you can see how the curve helps. Don't get complacent, though! I now expect some *spine-crushingly good* papers from you.
